At each trail stop anglers will be earning points, cash, sponsorship prizes, and qualifying for the Tennessee State Championship, Kayak Bass Fishing National Championships, and the Tournament of Champions.

The times listed above are when registration opens, and registration will last approximately 30 minutes. Launch will take place 15-20 minutes after the close of the Captain's meeting. If you are going to be late please call one of the numbers at the bottom of this flyer.

All entries must be paid in cash at the time of registration. All anglers must sign a release of liability, acknowledging they know and understand all rules.

 Only cash excepted, please bring exact cash.

- Last Cast Productions will be donating one private filmed fishing trip.
- Tennessee Moving Waters will be donating one free fishing trip to the 1st angler that surpasses 200 inches.

- PFD must be worn at all times on the water.
- Using KAST Rules
- A 360 degree white light must be used before daylight, or after sunset.
- All events are catch, photo, and release.
- Only black bass (largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted) minimum of 12".
- Paddlecraft only "Kayaks, Canoes, SUPS, no motorized watercraft".
- Artificial Lures only
- All Anglers must bring their Hawg Trough to registration, and Captains meeting.
- Hawg Trough is the official measuring device, lines must be darkened, and bump contrasting.
- Lip of the Hawg Trough must be contrasting
- No Entry Youth Division with guaranteed prizes 8" minimum fish
- Only 1 rod may be used at a time
- All anglers must wear their PFD to the Captains meeting.
- Waiver must be signed and rules understood. prior to getting on the water.
