- PFD must be worn at all times while on the water.
- KAST Rules will be used so familiarize yourself with them.
- A 360 degree white light must be used before daylight, or after sunset.
- All events are catch, photo, and release.
- Only black bass (largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted) minimum of 12".
- Paddlecraft only "Kayaks, Canoes, SUPS, "no motorized watercraft unless authorized before hand i.e. handicap".
- Artificial Lures only
- All Anglers must bring their Hawk Trough to registration, and Captains meeting.
- Hawk Trough will be the official measuring device, lines and bump must be contrasting.
- Eye, and complete fish must be visible along with identifier.
- No Entry Youth Division with guaranteed prizes 8" minimum fish
- Only 1 rod may be used at a time
- Waiver must be signed and rules understood. prior to getting on the water.
